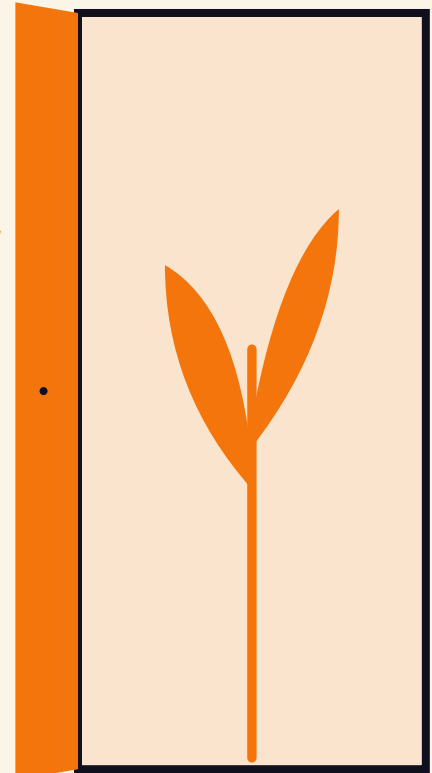




# Your phone, your way. *Settings made easy.*

— WHY THIS MATTERS

# Your phone is built to fit YOU.

Every phone has a Settings app — a place where you can change how it looks and sounds. Most people never open it, and live with tiny text, low ringtones, and a screen that's too dim.

Spending 5 minutes here will make your phone much easier to use every day.

STEP 1 OF 5

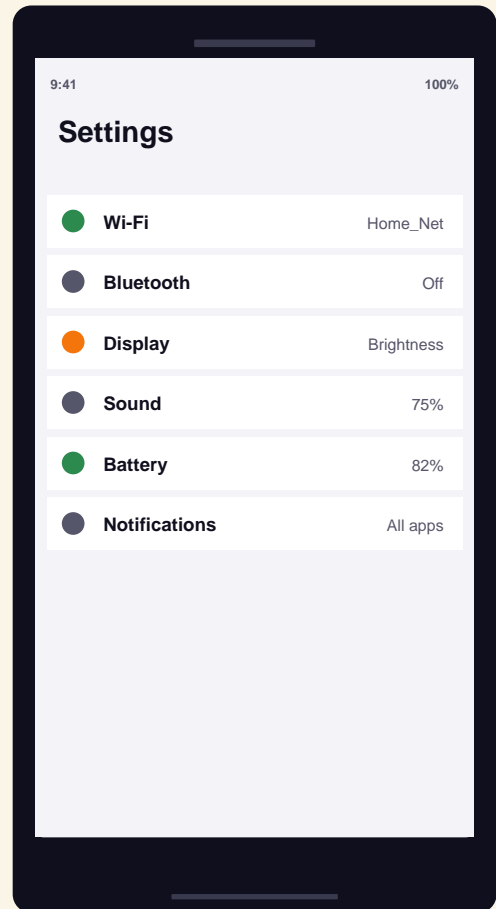
## Find the Settings app

Look for a small grey gear-shaped icon on your home screen. It may be on page 1, or you may need to swipe to find it.

Tap once on this icon to open Settings.

**TIP**

If you can't find it, swipe down from the top of the screen and tap the gear icon there.

STEP 2 OF 5

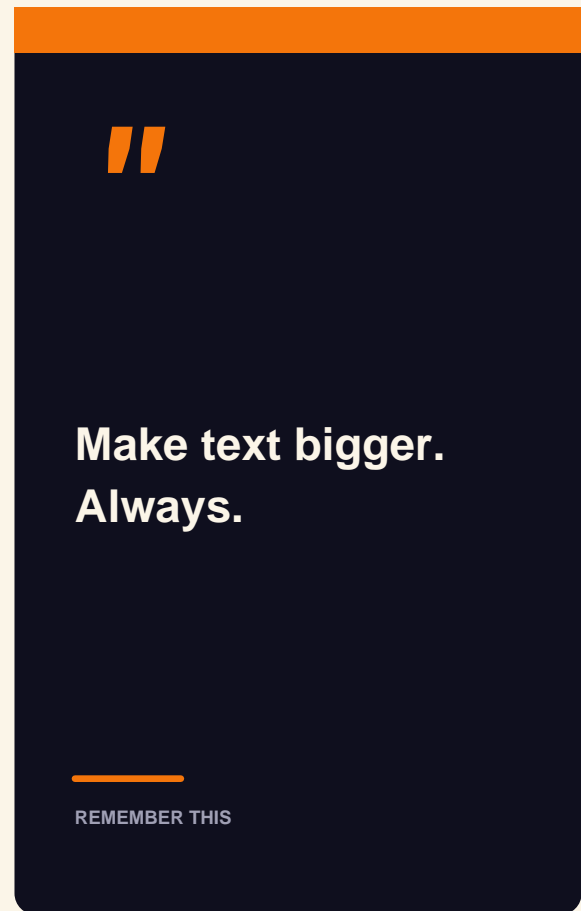
## Make text bigger

In Settings, look for 'Display' or 'Display & Brightness'.

Tap it. Then tap 'Font Size' or 'Text Size'. Drag the slider to the right until words feel comfortable to read.

**TIP**

Make text one or two sizes bigger than you think you need. Your eyes will thank you.

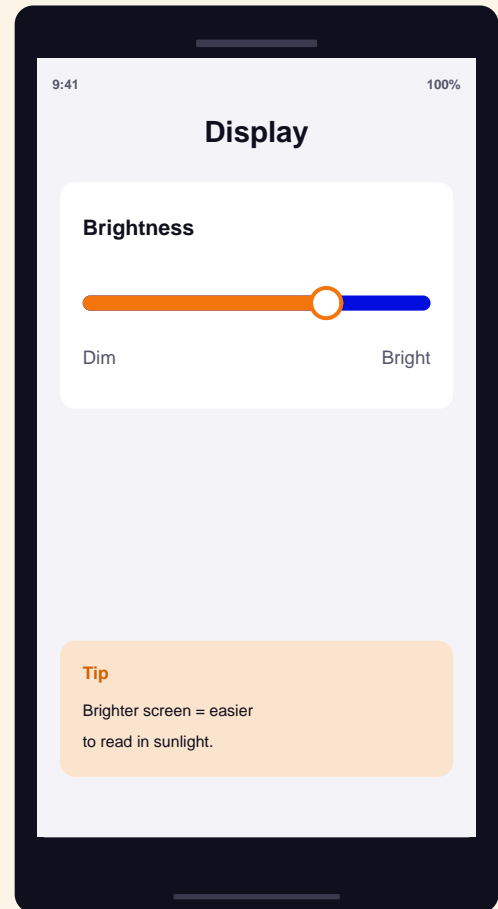
## Brighten your screen

Inside Display settings, find 'Brightness'. Drag the slider to the right.

If your phone has 'Auto-Brightness', turn it ON — your screen will adjust automatically as light changes.

**TIP**

A brighter screen is much easier to read in sunlight or by a window.

STEP 4 OF 5

## Turn up the ringtone

Go back to Settings. Find 'Sound' or 'Sounds & Vibration'.

Drag 'Ringtone' to maximum. Drag 'Notification' high too. This way you'll never miss a call from family.

**TIP**

Turn vibration ON as well — you'll feel the phone in your pocket even if you don't hear it.



**Loud ring. Strong vibrate. Never miss a call.**

## Save these settings

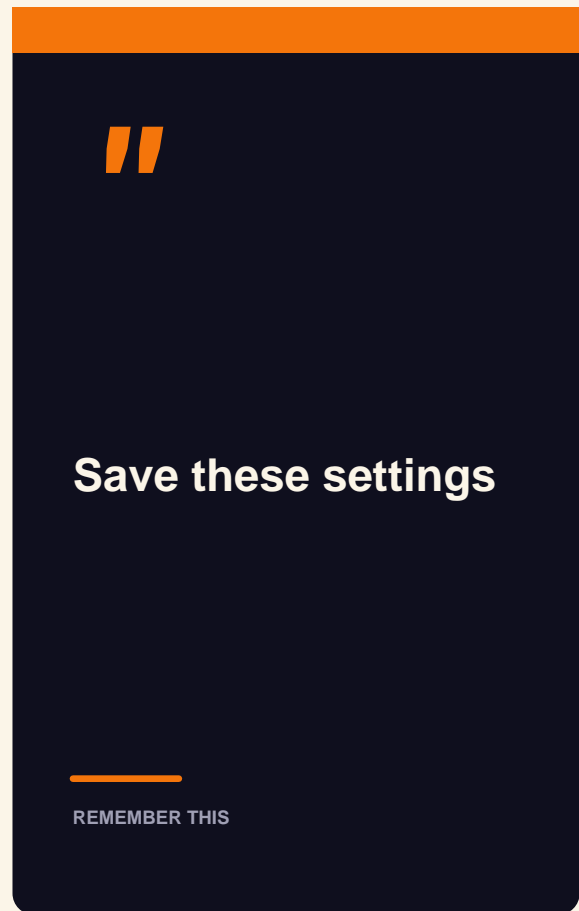
Once you've changed these settings, just press the home button or swipe up. Your changes are saved automatically.

There is no 'Save' button to press. Don't worry — your phone remembers everything.



### WARNING

**Don't change settings you don't understand. If you tap something by mistake, just press home and try again. You can't break your phone with Settings.**

# 5 things to remember.

**1**

## **Settings is a gear icon**

Look for a small grey gear on your home screen. Or swipe down from the top and tap the gear there.

**2**

## **Display = text size and brightness**

Inside Settings, 'Display' controls how things look. Make text bigger and screen brighter.

**3**

## **Sound = ringtone volume**

Inside Settings, 'Sound' controls how loud calls and notifications are. Turn them up high.

**4**

## **Settings are saved automatically**

There's no Save button. Just go back to home when you're done. Your phone remembers.

**5**

## **You can't break it**

If something looks wrong, just go back. You can always change settings again later.
