— WHY THIS MATTERS

## Distance doesn't matter when you can see them.

WhatsApp video calls are free. They work between any two phones with WhatsApp installed and internet — anywhere in the world.

Beti in Bangalore. Beta in Boston. Grandchildren on holiday. Tap a video icon and you're face-to-face in seconds. Better than phone calls, by miles.

- Start a video call
- Pick up an incoming video call
- Add more people to a call

STEP 1 OF 6

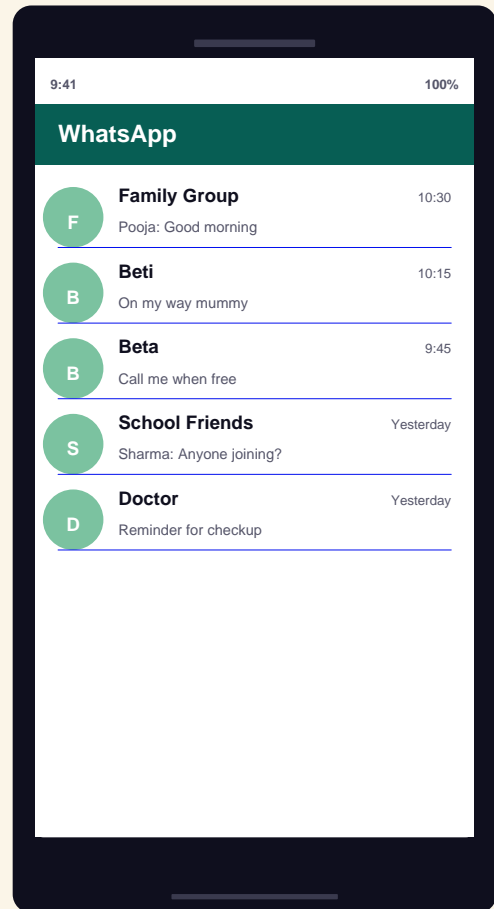
## Open WhatsApp and find the person

Open WhatsApp. Find the person you want to call in your chats list.

Tap their name to open the chat. Then look at the top-right of the screen.

**TIP**

If they're not in your chats yet, find them in 'Calls' tab. WhatsApp also has a Contacts list.

STEP 2 OF 6

## Tap the video camera icon

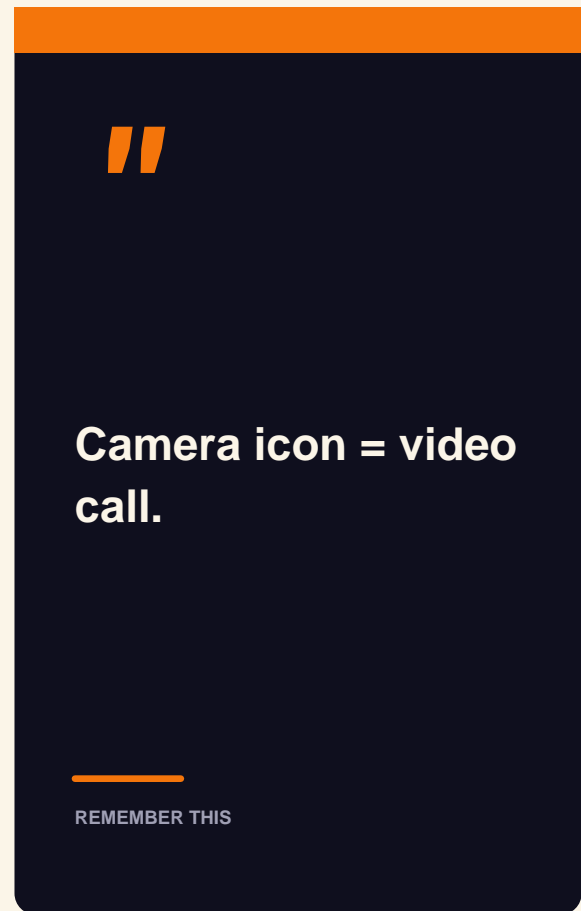
At the top-right, you'll see two icons:

- Phone icon → voice call
- Video camera icon → video call

Tap the VIDEO CAMERA icon. The other person's phone starts ringing.

● **TIP**

First time? WhatsApp asks permission for camera and microphone. Tap 'Allow' for both.

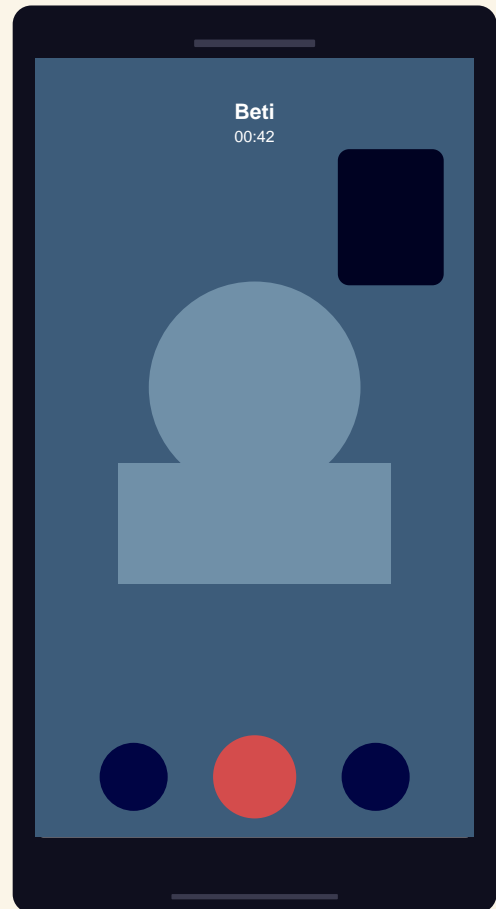
## Wait for them to answer

When the call connects, you see THEIR face.  
They see YOUR face.

A small box in the corner shows YOU (so you can check how you look). The big screen is them. Talk normally.

**TIP**

Hold the phone with both hands at face level. Camera should be at your eye level — not pointed up your nose.

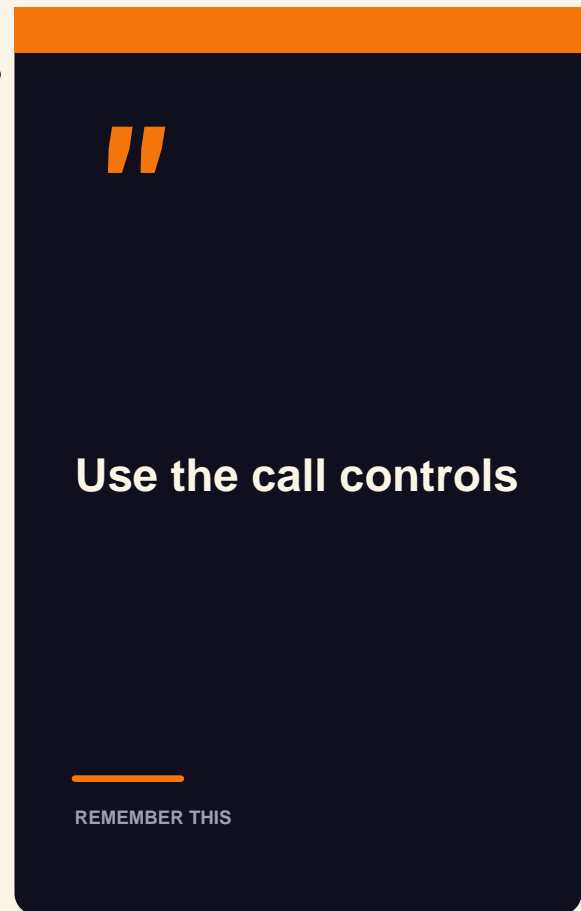
## Use the call controls

At the bottom of the screen during a call:

- Microphone icon → mute (they can't hear you)
- Camera icon → turn off your video
- Switch camera icon → swap to back camera
- Red phone icon → end call

● **TIP**

If you need to step away, mute yourself first.  
They won't hear background noise.

STEP 5 OF 6

## Add more people

During the call, you'll see a 'Add participant' or '+' icon.

Tap it. Choose another person from your contacts. Both old and new people are now on the same call. You can add up to 8 people total.

**TIP**

Family group calls — beti, beta, grandchildren — all on one screen. Sunday tradition for many families now.

STEP 6 OF 6

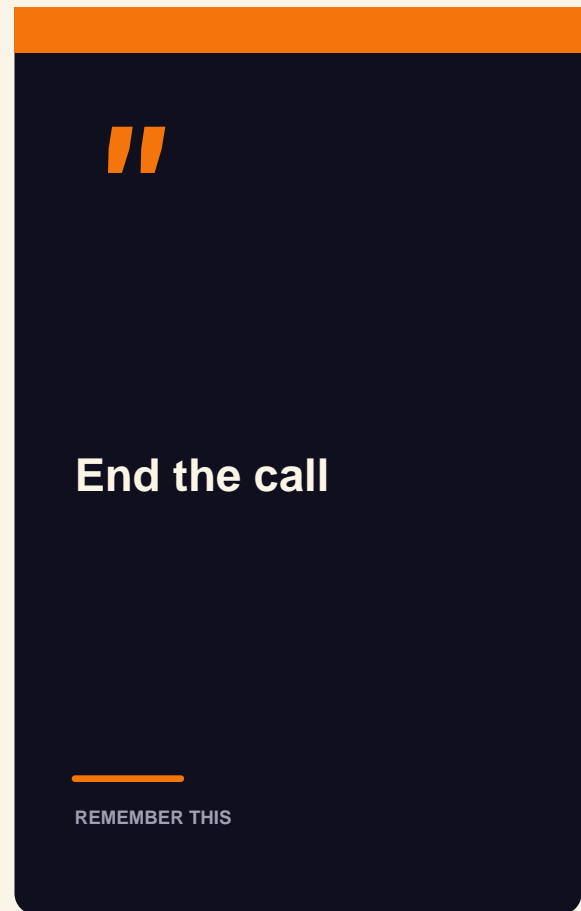
## End the call

When done, tap the RED PHONE icon at the bottom.

The call ends. The screen returns to your chat. The other person also gets the 'call ended' message.

**TIP**

Don't worry — they won't be offended. Both sides see 'call ended' equally. Standard goodbye.

— QUICK RECAP

# Face-to-face, anywhere.

**1**

## Open chat first

Find the person in WhatsApp. Tap their name. Then look top-right for the video icon.

**2**

## Camera icon = video call

Two icons at top-right. Phone is voice call. Camera is video call. Tap camera.

**3**

## Hold at eye level

Camera should be at your face level. Not below (shows your nose). Not above (you look down).

**4**

## Mute when not talking

If background is noisy, tap the microphone icon to mute. They can still see you, but no noise.

**5**

## Red phone = goodbye

When done, tap the red phone icon. The call ends. Both sides know it's over.
