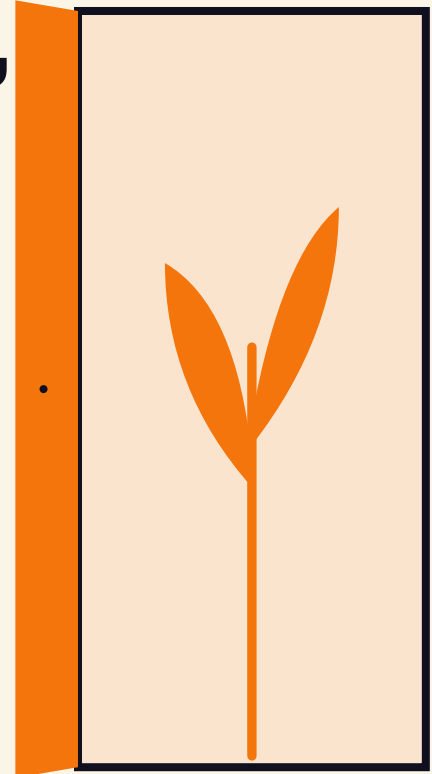

YouTube for everything visual

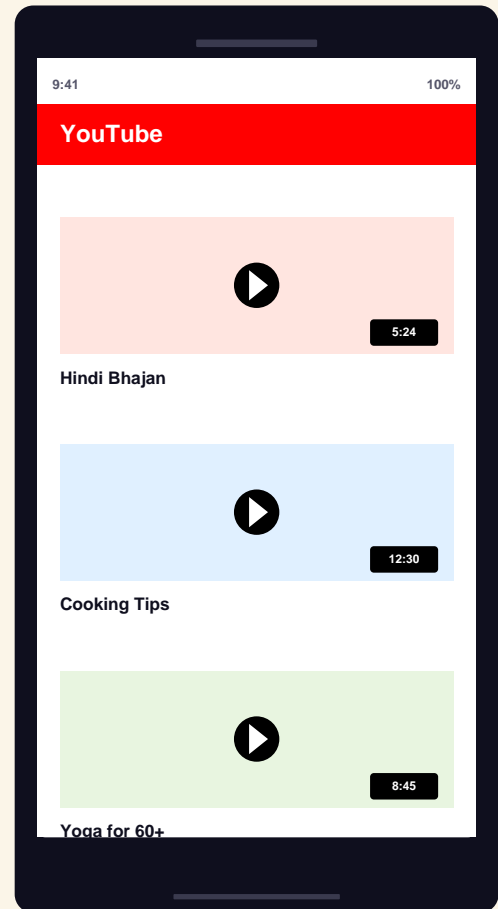
YouTube has every kind of devotional video:

- Live aartis from temples (Tirumala, Vaishno Devi, Shirdi)
- Pravachans by sadhus and gurus
- Bhajans with lyrics on screen
- Religious stories for grandchildren

Search 'Hanuman Chalisa', 'Vishnu Sahasranamam', or any name.

TIP

Subscribe to your favorite temple or guru's channel. New content reaches you automatically.

STEP 2 OF 6

Spotify for audio bhajans

Spotify is for music — including bhajans and religious music. Free version works fine.

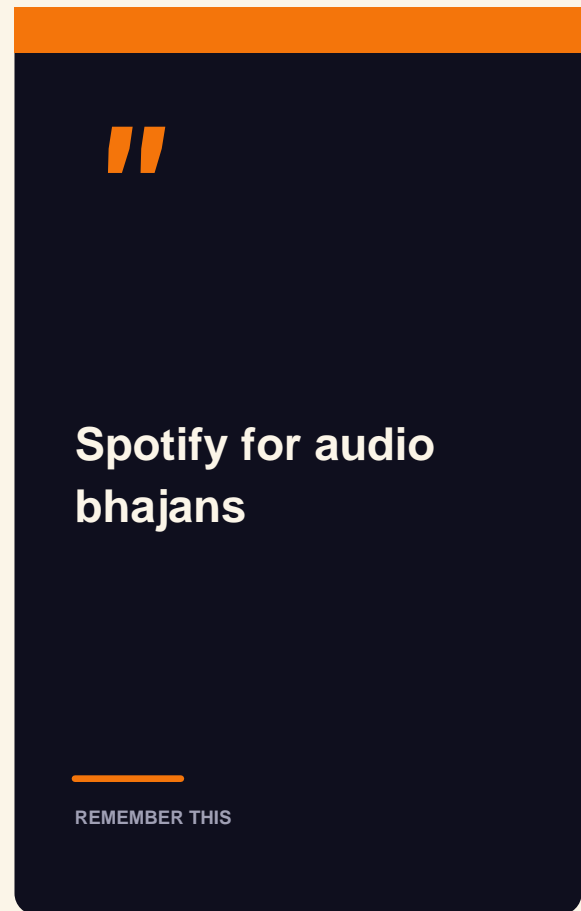
Search any artist:

- Lata Mangeshkar bhajans
- M.S. Subbulakshmi
- Anup Jalota
- Jagjit Singh ghazals

Make playlists for morning, evening, festivals.

● **TIP**

Spotify lets you download songs to your phone — no internet needed when listening. Look for the download arrow.

STEP 3 OF 6

Pick festival-specific content

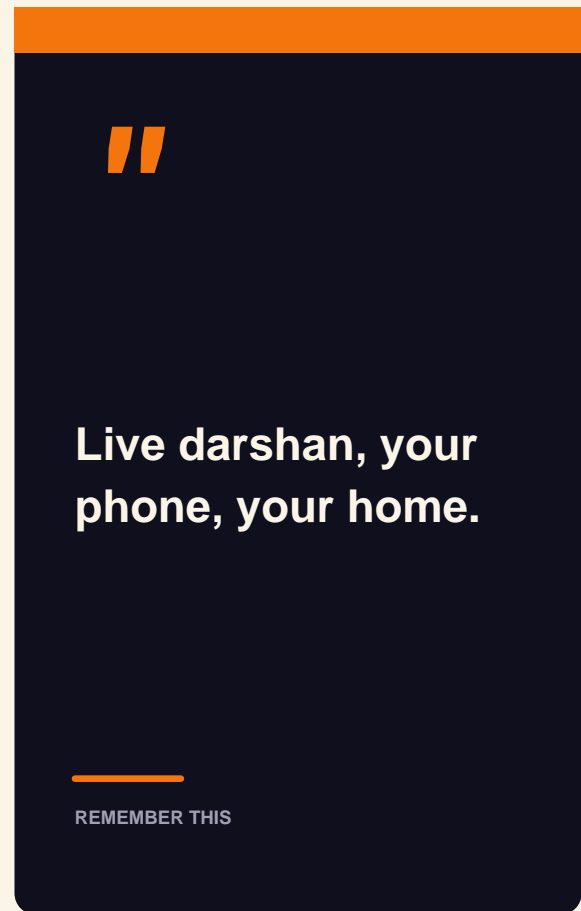
Both apps have ready-made playlists for festivals:

- Diwali songs
- Ganesh Chaturthi bhajans
- Navaratri devi songs
- Christmas carols
- Janmashtami stories

Search 'Diwali bhajans' or 'Navaratri Garba' before festivals.

● **TIP**

On festival days, search for live darshans from temples. Many telecast live on YouTube.

STEP 4 OF 6

Set bhajans as morning alarm

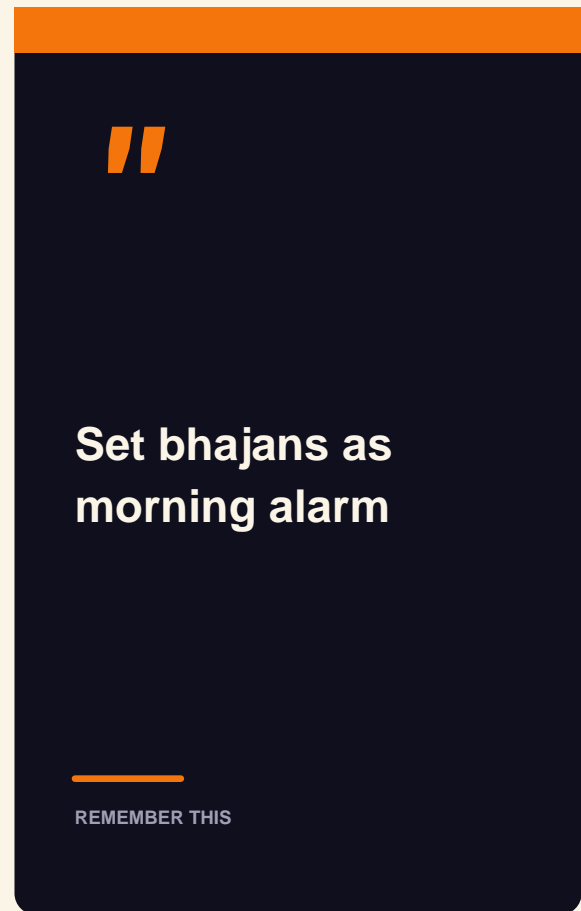
Some Android phones let you set music as your alarm.

Open Clock app → Alarm → Set time → Pick sound → 'From device' → Pick a bhajan you've downloaded.

Wake up to Suprabhatam every morning.

TIP

If your phone doesn't allow this, use the 'Alarm' feature in Spotify Premium, or install 'Devotional Alarm' apps.

STEP 5 OF 6

Watch live temple darshan

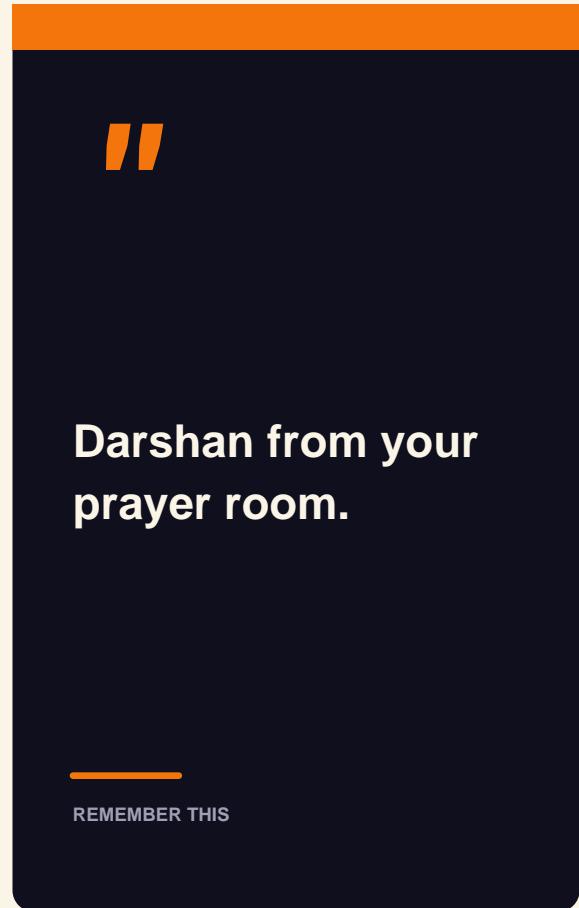
Major Indian temples now broadcast LIVE on YouTube:

- Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanam (TTD)
- Vaishno Devi Shrine Board
- Shirdi Sai Baba Sansthan
- Siddhivinayak Temple, Mumbai
- Most major temples

Search the temple name + 'live darshan'.

● **TIP**

Schedule reminders for daily aarti times.
Watch from home with full devotion.

STEP 6 OF 6

Be careful of fake content

Some channels post AI-generated or fake religious content designed to scare you or get you to share.

Stick to:

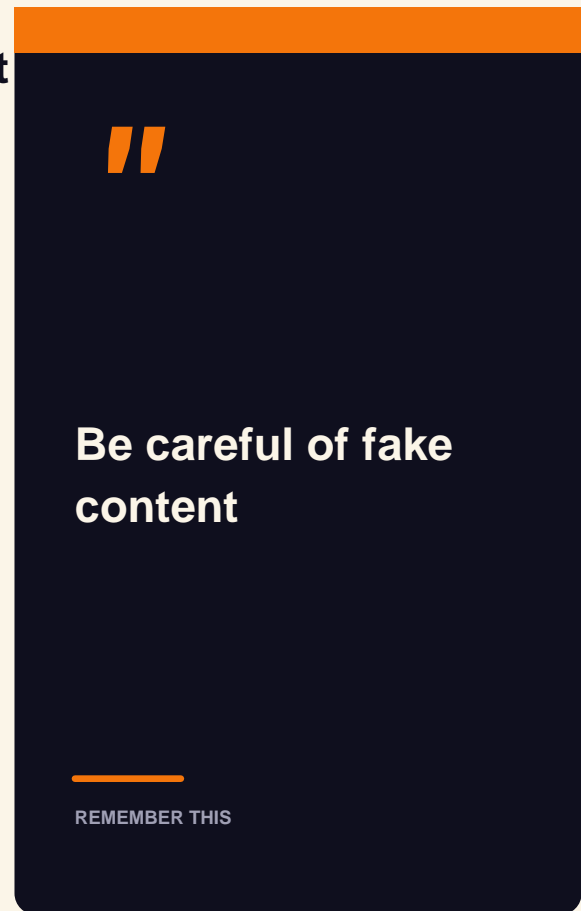
- Official temple channels (verified, blue tick)
- Well-known gurus and singers
- Channels with millions of subscribers

Avoid 'forward this or your family will suffer' content.



WARNING

Real devotion brings peace. If a video makes you scared or asks you to forward to others — it's fake. Real bhajans never threaten.

Aartis, pravachans, live temple darshan — all on YouTube. Free. Subscribe to favorites.

Spotify for audio

Bhajans, slokas, ghazals — Spotify has it all. Free version works fine. Download for offline.

Festival playlists ready

For Diwali, Navaratri, Ganesh Chaturthi — search festival name. Ready playlists appear.

Live temple darshan

Tirumala, Vaishno Devi, Siddhivinayak, Shirdi — all broadcast live on YouTube. Watch from home.

Real devotion brings peace

If content makes you scared or asks you to forward — it's fake. Skip it. Real bhajans only soothe.
